Very beautiful carved lime stoup decorated with foliage scrolls and vine branches. the back part in the form of an escutcheon offers a beautiful work of very finely openwork sculpture, this part is monoxyl and the part forming a holy water font is also carved from a single piece of linden. a very beautiful walnut-colored patina adorns this beautiful stoup. in the center of the floral escutcheon is cut an oval medallion adorned with a very beautiful painted porcelain plaque representing the face of Christ wearing the crown of thorns. this porcelain plate is in perfect condition and is

enhanced by its floral frame, a very successful and very decorative marriage.
