Primitive Bono (1880-1955) painter of Italian origin born in Brescia, he exhibited at the salon of French artists from 1920 to 1929 of which he was a member, he settled in Algeria and the first exhibitions in 1923 in Oran, reveal him at public, he travels in southern Algeria and Morocco. Painter of typical scenes of everyday life, landscapes and portraits.
