Gouache drawing of the grand canal in Versailles at the end of the 19th century Drawing made at the south-eastern end of the grand canal. The author is placed at the end of the alley of the sailors, with the Apollo basin on the right and in perspective, the alley of the Porte St Antoine, the porch of which can be seen at the end of this view. (see photo taken on site) French school end of the 19th century, unsigned. Louis XVI style ribbons frame gilded with bronze leaf, beige cardboard mat with gilt bevel, old glass. Overexposure of the glass in the photo may result in a milky appearance. Some freckles on the top of the table. Frame measures 0.52x0.48 Unframed measures 0.28x0.21
