If he was the pupil in Paris of Gérôme, whose influence is felt here in the treatment of bathers, he is best known as a painter from Poitevin who left many paintings on the peasant world as his historical or religious work. fail to eclipse. The academic current often presented works involving nudes in different contexts which only served as a pretext for the Salon. Our canvas is a charming example, the appearance of this hermit causing the panic of this swarm of young bathers...
