It was a war and hunting horn, it was used to give signals, to rally the troops, to announce the approach of an enemy. The olifant was therefore an instrument carried by the chiefs, or a man who followed them. Good general condition, with traces of use. To report small chips at the base of the horn. Length 35 cm.
