



Flowers In A Stone Urn By Jean-baptist Monnoyer (1634 - 1699) - Workshop



Description

A masterful still life with flowers in a stone urn with a landscape in the background was executed at the end of the 17th century in the style and quality of the famous Franco-Flemish flower painter Jean-Baptiste Monnoyer (1636 Lille -1699 London).
