The two miniatures are signed Lebrun.

Rosalie Vaysse-Lebrun (born Le Brun), is a painter of portraits and miniatures. She was a student of J.B Isabey. She appeared at the Salon of 1799 and 1801 in Paris.

It is listed in the Benezit.

The king wears the decoration of the Holy Spirit.

Large and very beautiful qualities, they are on ivories.
