Interesting oil on canvas from the 17th century representing an interpretation of the agony of Christ in the garden of olive trees.

it is an episode in the life of Christ shortly before his arrest when abandoned to doubt and fear of his impending passion, an angel comforts him and brings him the chalice of his sacrifice.

Jesus, lying on the rocks, his head back, seems to be unconscious, lost, an angel supporting him in his despair.

a second angel appearing in clouds and accompanied by divine light hands him a chalice. while a little angel supports a cross.

we also speak of the passage of Jesus to the Mount of Olives.

Our representation of this famous passage from the bible to a very dreamlike side with many
