Lower part forming a chest of drawers opening onto three drawers on the facade, abundant in gilded bronze on the entire cabinet. Dressed in its original white marble, high quality furniture of execution with a lot of character and charm. Entirely period furniture with a small restoration has a rear foot but in no way altering the quality and the beauty of this piece. Non-functional drawer locks omitted that of the flap.
