

# Pair Of Cloisonés Vases, Japan, 1900



## Description

Beautiful pairs of vases, in chiseled bronze, with partitioned decorations, with dragons, and animals with handles.

First applied to jewelry, the cloisonné decoration (goldsmith's technique), will gain in popularity and extend to the decpraive arts. The partition will be used for metal vases, then for ceramics and enamel objects.

For this technique, it is a question of defining the outline of the patterns using a thin metal strip welded to the field of the metal. The cells thus obtained are filled with enamel.

Everything is then cooked and sanded. Our vases are also in chiseled bronze: the chisel work
