Description

Pretty gouache representing a Marine signed Engalière and dated 1851. The scene is located on the shores of the Mediterranean, a priori in the south of France. It could be the surroundings of Marseille, Toulon, thanks to this old building on the left side. Someone living in this region or knowing this place may be able to light our lantern! This gouache is oval in shape and measures 19 cm x 13.5 cm for the visible part. Overall frame: 33.5 cm x 27 cm. The framework is, a priori, original. The painter Marius Engalière was born in Marseille and died in Paris, 1824-1857; he died very young, 33 years old and had a lot of talent! He painted a lot in Provence, his native region. However, we found a humanized painting (gouache) reminiscent of ours in Gibraltar with a selling price I believe at
