Dimensions: 105cm x 85cm framed approx Jan van Os 1744 - 1808 Jan van Os was born in Middelharnis. He was trained by animal painter, still life and decorator Aert Schouman (1710-1792) in The Hague, and joined the Brotherhood of Painters in 1773. Van Os spent the rest of his life in The Hague, although he enjoyed an international reputation and exhibited paintings in London, France and Germany. He
