Decor of a scene of an Express Pony pursued by Indians (rapid mail delivery service in the USA, in service between April 3, 1860 and Oct 1861, connecting in 10 days, ST-Joseph in Missouri to Sacramento in California passing through the great plains, the rocky mountains and the Sierra Nevada with all the risks associated with adventure) Dimensions: Length: 4.45 m. Height: 2.95 m. Ideal decoration on the "Far West" theme. Good general condition of conservation and use, good freshness of colors, see all photos. No hitch, unsigned by the artist, from an old decor having served in a fairground, closed in the 1970s. Shipping costs included for FRANCE.
