### Description

Authentic Edo period Jingasa, conical Samurai headdress, known as Toppai Jingasa in wood with black lacquer on the outside, depicting the gold lacquered kamon which represents the "Tachibana" or "Hikone Tachibana" clan. The interior is lacquered in red and black. In very good state of preservation, some minor gaps at the ends. The interior with zabuton, a protective cushion for the head and a chin bar, called ago-himo, is present but not attached to the helmet. Diameter: 37.5 cm Height: 9 cm
