From Maison Letang Fils created in 1832 in Paris, famous for its chocolate molds, two old chocolate molds in tinned iron. Very good quality of molding. Carrying out its activity in Paris, first Rue Quincampoix, the company moved in 1891 to a building it bought at 108 Rue Vieille du Temple, address stamped on our 2 molds next to the name of the House. In 1900, she participated in its 5th Universal Exhibition in Paris and once again distinguished itself there. She was already "the supplier to the whole world". Dimensions: "Egg" mold: 12.4 cm x 11.7 cm and 1.8 cm thick "Shell" mold: 14 cm x 8, 7 cm and 1.5 cm thick Models numbered 2644 and 2629 and mark stamped in stick letters LETANG FILS 108 rue Vieille du Temple Paris on the border.
