### Description

Lacquer panel depicting a Vietnamese landscape made in the early 20th century.

The back bears the mark "my nghe" meaning ce qui signifie crafts in vietnamese, then the initials "V-N" maybe for Viêt Nam ? and "T N".

The lacquer is considered as one of the traditionnal painting craft in Vietnam, even though we think more often of China and Japan. The village Tuong Binh Hiep is famous in the whole country since centuries for being the birthplace of the lacquer art. Since 1930, the main place is Hanoi, gathering the most famous artists such as Tran Dinh Tho, Nguyen Gia Tri, Pham Hau, Nguyen Khang, Tran Van Can or even Dinh Van Thanh.
