Description

The painting under glass, or "fixed under glass", consists in carrying out the work of painting on the back of a glass plate. One of the difficulties of the process is to paint the inverted motif and, unlike the normal technique, to execute the details, before the background, the spectator having to look at the finished work on the unpainted side of the glass plate. The craftsman uses oil or gouache colors mixed with a special glue. This fixed coaster signed P.casiez, art Deco, circa 1930/40, representing a Breton market scene. Signed painting, unidentified, from Finistère. In good general condition. To report a small jump of paint on the point of the bell-tower. Dimensions 52 cm by 82 cm.
