Box decorated in Arte Povera technic with a mythological scene of Poseidon on his quadriga, on the half-paneled lid. The interior of the paper box dominated by a grid with lillies. Inside the cover a sea monster on a red painted background surrounded by a frame of foliage and flowers on a white background.

- Box probably from a toilet, a fashionable object at the end of the 17th century. Following the sumptuary edicts of Louis XIV prohibiting the
