Elegant Bonheur Du Jour in Marquetry inspired by Grand Master Cabinetmakers such as Topino, Kemp .. Our Bonheur Du Jour is from the Louis XV period, not stamped but deserves to be ... The tier is recessed, it has a niche central framed by small leaves inlaid with vases with flowers in light wood and tinted on a light wood background, bordered by a green tinted wood border. The so-called "ustentiles" marquetry .. is similar to TOPINO's work .. The central part opens to a central drawer and 2 smaller drawers on each side, it has an eventful cutout surrounding flower patterns. The belt contains a writing tablet covered with an old gilded leather with small irons still in very good condition, which reveals behind this writing case, 3 "secret" compartments which are closed by strips of tinted
