Mahogany, opening with two leaves simulating curtains and revealing a shelf. A drawer. The uprights and fluted feet terminated by round shoes are joined by a tablet surrounded by an openwork bronze gallery. White veined marble top surrounded by an openwork bronze gallery, also. This piece of furniture is in Louis XVI style and from the beginning of the 20 th century. It is called an in-between cabinet because it was intended for small spaces: between two windows or between two panels of woodwork. Delivery possible, please consult us.
