




French Renaissance Sculpture Documents P.vitry And G.brière Dalonguet Editor

Published by Ateliers photomécaniques DA Longuet - 250 Faubourg Saint-Martin Paris. 1911 First part including the table pages of the plates, 92 plates -570 statuary and decoration documents. Second part including the table pages of the plates, 100 plates - 545 statuary and decoration documents. Interior in very good condition despite the insolated table pages and some foxing. Pearl gray wallets, one of which is a little isolated. Red canvas back in good condition despite wear.
