SUCCEEDED TO HIS FATHER IN 1815 IN
THE VERY PROSPEROUS FAMILY
BUSINESS DURING THE PERIOD OF THE
EMPIRE WITH UP TO 400 EMPLOYEES.
ALTHOUGH HE RECEIVED SEVERAL
AWARDS FOR THE WORK OF HIS GOLDEN
BRONZES, HE FOUND NO SUPPORT FOR
THE NEW REGIME AND FOUND GREAT
FINANCIAL DIFFICULTIES FOR THE REST
OF HIS LIFE;

MAJESTIC PENDULUM IN PURE WHITE

WITH ORMULUS BRONZE PATTERNS THE
