### Description

Victor Gabriel Gilbert was a pupil of Victor Adam and Charles Busson, he painted many views of Paris enlivened with flower-sellers. He was best known for his vegetable, poultry and fish-market scenes, and, above all, his flower markets.

Les Halles were the commercial heart of Paris, a place of exchange and supply to the abundant life that had developed over the centuries.
