René DUBOIS (1737-1799) received as Master cabinetmaker on June 25, 1755) rare small in-between chest of drawers in the shape of a tomb curved on its three sides in rosewood veneer and violet wood inlaid in curling, on softwood backgrounds and oak, rich ornamentation of chiseled and gilded bronzes such as; ; scraps, clogs, keyholes, pull handles, original, it is capped with its original white veined red marble, (old restoration of a filled crack) it opens with three rows of drawers on the front, the locks are present, (a non-functional key) it is stamped R BUBOIS on the front corner, in good general condition, some defects due to time, pretty gilding of the bronzes dimensions height 87cm length 82cm depth 47.5cm Bibio; René DUBOIS is the son of Jacques DUBOIS, eminent master of
