Some examples of famous breast cup or bowl:

- The breast bowl or nipple bowl from the service of the Sèvres factory for the Rambouillet dairy, which legend says it was modeled after the image of the left breast of Queen Marie Antoinette.
 - the breast cut of Jean Baptiste Claude Odier after the breast of Pauline Borghese sister of Napoleon, known for its frivolity.
 - the electrum breast cup at Lindos on the island of Rhodes in the temple of the neck brace which would have been molded on Helena's breast and which was considered the most beautiful breast in the world. Would our copy be the porcelain representation of Helene's breast?
- Was it made in France, in Sèvres?
