The sculpture is in polychrome wood. The artist sculpted the group in an intricate and decorative way, applying polychromy in layers to the wood. It shows a Chinese boy on an elephant, holding a wicker basket in one hand and a bat in the other, a symbol of happiness in China, and very often his images appeared on Chinese pottery and other works of art. art. The image of the elephant came to China with the spread of Buddhism and was avidly featured in the visual arts.
