Rare and interesting engagement or wedding chest, in wood entirely sheathed in Cordoba leather with polychrome decoration of bouquets of flowers on three sides and the cover of garlands of flowers and bronze nails, brass cladding, the interior is lined with camphor wood, side handles in gilded brass, original pennetriangular lock, bronze escutcheon keyhole, Spanish work from the colony of the Philippines from the end of the 18th century or the very beginning of the 19th century, similar model sale ducal collections chateau d'Uzez. a small lack of leather on one of the ribs
