Contemporary painter of Polish origin and jazz pianist. He exhibits in the company of Jacques Monory, Bernard Rancillac and Jan Voss and is close to narrative figuration. In the years 1955-1960, he was a pupil of André Lothe then Robert Lapoujade. Independent of mind, he wanted to free himself from group influences to develop alone his technique and his artistic vision, between figuration and abstraction, faithful to the teaching received.
