Fernand Fau,(1858-1925)

is a French painter, illustrator and caricaturist. He worked for many major newspapers of caricature of his time, as the Laugh. He signed his work sometimes under the pseudonyms of Fô or Phô

During his career, he collaborates in particular for the decorations of one of the greatest Parisian cabarets: the Black Cat. There he created the shadow theater for Une Affaire d'honneur by Jules Jouy, and then in 1890, composed Idylle, a one-act revue written with Charles de Sivry.

Our pastel is a very typical representation of a part of his production. Fernand Fau, likes to paint naked women and also water and its reflections.
