Jean Touret was born on April 7, 1916 in Mayenne. He is preparing to become a small administrative executive in an insurance company in Le Mans, when the war reveals to him his true artistic personality and forges a compelling vision of the world. On his return he began a career as a painter, then turned to woodcarving. He immediately performs monumental spiritual works, which will inhabit a multitude of churches and chapels. All his life he
