Moreau and Flameng, he exhibited regularly at the Salon des Artistes Français in Paris, of which he became a member and where he obtained an honorable mention in 1920. He was also a member of the Salon des Tuileries. Condition: As is, some stains on the outside of the drawing, paper wear and slight lack of color on the shoulder of the second character from the left (see photo n $^{\circ}$ 5)
