In 1962 he was deeply impressed by an exhibition on Bacon at the Galleria d'Arte Moderna in Turin and, the following year, he participated in the 121st Esposizione della Società Promotrice di Belle Arti with a drawing by Leonardo. He made copies of Rembrandt, Van Gogh, Fontana and Chagall. He frequented the circle of artists of Arte Povera and some important critics, such as Renato Barilli, Germano Celant and Achille Bonito Oliva. In 1970, he presented a series of self-portraits at the
