At that time in his life, Christopher Columbus was poor and had only one donkey. However, he has already had a similar offer from the English Court.

Hence the title of the work "The New World in the West for England or for Spain?"

John Rogers Herbert, is a famous painter founder of the Royal Academy, who painted many historical paintings, in a pre-Raphaelite style.
