End burns table perfume from the Kadjar period, in extremely fine copper in decoration and carving, from the XIXth century.

Decorated with six finely engraved medallions specific to Persian history featuring a character per medallion in different positions.

These medallions are placed on a bed of arabesques and roses, accompanied by small cartouches of flowers and birds.

Beautiful friezes surround the whole on several occasions.

Two very light indentations without gravity for the quality of the part. Beautiful patina due to age, a beautiful piece for an enlightened enthusiast.
