rue des Beaux-Arts, in Paris. Others will follow, notably at the Galerie Etienne de Cousance, still

in Paris. She presented herself for the Prix de

Rome in 1959. The same year, she met, at the

Beaux-Arts, the one who would become her

husband, Jean Hamon. From 1972, and this for 20

years, she exhibited, with her husband, at the
