\* Élisabeth Philippe Marie Hélène de France,  
known as Madame Élisabeth, born May 3, 1764  
in Versailles and died guillotined on May 10,  
1794 in Paris .

She is the eighth and last child of the Dauphin  
Louis and Marie-Josèphe de Saxe.

Sister of King Louis XVI, she gave him  
unwavering support during the French  
Revolution.

Imprisoned with the royal family in 1792 and  
called to appear before the Revolutionary Court  
under the Terror, she was condemned to death  
and executed.
