Picard; "Reclining Woman and Two Cherubs" The hanging represents a young woman dressed in the Antique, lying down who has removed her wedding ring and looks at her thoughtfully. She is leaning on a flowered mound closing the movement. It surrounds a round-shaped dial, enamelled in white, indicating the hours in Roman numerals and the minutes in Arabic numerals signed "Raingo Fres / à Paris". The
