MORIN Charles Camille (1846 - 1919) Young girl with a goat - Oil on canvas signed lower left -Old frame gilded with leaf - Cnvas size: 58 X 91 cm - Frame size: 88 X 112 cm - MORIN Charles Camille (1846 - 1919) French painter 19th-20th century - Born June 19, 1846 in Paris. Died January 8, 1919 in Courbevoie - In the wake of the Barbizon school, he painted landscapes of Ile de France, Brittany and the South - Exhibitor at the Salon of French Artists from 1889 to 1898, he became a member in 1897 - From 1888 to 1890 he published chronicles and reviews in the Journal des Artistes, some under the signature of Camille Miron - He invented a system of models reproducing the movement of the characters, for painting in the studio in the absence model -Museum: Carpentras "La Marne au Perreux" -
