The latter was specialized in metal ornaments for pipes, c ' It is on this date that he begins to melt and paint figurines. It is the beginning of the Vienna bronzes which would know a world fame. Towards the end of the 19th century, the golden age of metalworking in Vienna, many workshops were created. During the 19th century, artists created nearly 10,000 models of bronze figurines. These famous works were exported to major cities such as New York, London, and Paris.
