Painter, illustrator, poster artist, pastellist, draftsman, graphic artist.

Jules Grün was a student of Jean-Baptiste Lavastre, painter and decorator of the Paris Opera, and landscape painter Antoine Guillemet. His favorite themes are still life, portraits and scenes of Parisian life. The highlight of his painted work was the 1909 commission from the Under Secretary of State for Fine Arts, Étienne
