



Christ Alcove Crucifix In Ivory Open Mouth Eighteenth

Description

Beautiful alcove crucifix, also called bedside, with his Christ on the cross in Louis XV style in ivory, open V-shaped arms, on a black tinted wooden cross in a Regency style frame from a later period. The head of Christ, open mouth revealing his tongue, resting on his right shoulder and thus translating his exhaustion. In a few minutes he will be speaking his seventh and last word. Ample draped perizonium held by a cord leaving his right leg uncovered, legs and feet together and parallel. Fixed on the cross by thin original faceted nails. The cross is fixed on a garnet velvet with some wear. Titulus crucis INRI in ivory imitating a folded fabric, fixed by three faceted nails. Christ in good condition, no lack, some natural checks visible on photos. 18th century Dieppe work. Height (from the top of the
