Minister of External Relations under Napoleon but also Grand Chamberlain, he also has the titles of Prince de Bénevent or Duke of Dino. Between Ancien Régime and République, Talleyrand is a complex character, gifted in the field of international negotiations, he will be loved or hated. This oil on canvas taken in a wooden frame comes from the Château de Prat located in Ariège. Built in the 13th century, it was originally the home of the Counts of Comminges. This
