The brazier is complete with its 12 lying lion feet lion heads lying, upper part handles inscribed with interlocking « L » stylized monogram (for Louis XIV?). Accompanied by its St Jacques shell shape silver-plated bronze shovel.

Early XIXth cty stunning Spanish (or Portuguese?) colonial order work, for Mexican market ?
