Description

Biedermeier's watercolor depicts two charming children (brothers) catching songbirds. It was executed in 1840 by the famous Austrian watercolorist, miniaturist and lithographer Johann Baptist Clarot (1798 Vienna - 1855 Budapest). He was the son of the engraver Joseph Clarot and the brother of another well-known Viennese portrait painter and miniaturist Alexandre Clarot (1796 -1842). On our watercolor the artist left his souvenir inscription: "Meinem Bruder Alexander gewidmet" (in English: "dedicated to my brother Alexander"). From this inscription it can be assumed that the author painted this watercolor in 1840 in memory of distant childhood years and represents himself and his older brother Alexander, who was 2 years older than the author. .
