This painting represents Louis of France wearing the Blue Cord of the Order of St Esprit and the Order of the Golden Fleece tied to a red ribbon passed around his neck. This pastel of superb quality is of great finesse, the colors remain vivid and luminous; Several copies of this portrait are present in different museums. The whole in very good condition is presented in a period frame under a glass.
