Harbour scenes, Still Life, Flowers and Fruit. He studied drawing at the Collège de Saintes and began painting in buildings. At the age of 17, suffering from saturnism, he turned to easel painting initiated by Savarin, a painter from Bordeaux. Furcy de Lavault began his career as a portrait painter. He later specialized as a flower painter. Supported in his candidacy by local supporters, Furcy de Lavault was appointed curator of the Musée de
