Round porcelain box from Royal Copenhagen, with pale gray crackle decoration. The cover is surmounted by a small seated cherub, his quiver on his shoulder. Golden border. This box is marked both under the cover and under the base, with the symbol of the factory, as well as its number. Dated 1923 Art Deco period It is in perfect condition Bing & Grøndahl was a Danish porcelain manufacturer founded in 1853 by the sculptor Grøndahl and the Bing brothers, merchants. In 1987, Bing & Grøndahl merged with the Royal Porcelain Factory to become Royal Copenhagen.
