Elias Hainzelman is a pupil of François de Poilly, engraver of the second engraving proposed, he is inspired by his master to realize religious scenes and portraits. The second engraving: The rest of the Holy Family during the flight into Egypt is therefore the work of François de Poilly (1623-1693) engraver and publisher of prints.
