Tabriz, in northwestern Iran was a historic center of carpet production and is an area well known for its court rugs like the Ardébil carpet. Floral decor, often with a central medallion, the designs include flowering trees, shrubs and tall leaves. We also see specimens with animals and plant motifs.

Tabriz rugs are renowned for their sober palettes with a crystalline design, attributes that are clearly evident in this highly artistic piece, which is over 100 years old. In its uniquely contoured reserve, an elegant medallion holds its own fascinating interior design, while the bold contours reinforce the striking graphic quality of the composition. This piece demonstrates a consummate know-how.
