Roland Lecavelé, known as Roland Dorgelès, born June 15, 1885 in Amiens and died March 18, 1973 in Paris, is a French journalist and writer, member of the Académie Goncourt from 1929 to 1973. He is a famous and quite unclassifiable writer. He began his career in Montmartre. During the First World War, he joined the fighting when he was reformed for health reasons, he even became an airplane pilot and obtained the Croix de Guerre. Then he was a journalist for the Canard Enchaîné. His greatest literary success remains "Les Croix de bois". Good condition.
